### STEPS TO USE DHA APP IN DONATING BLOOD

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- 1. Download DHA App
- 2. Click on Dammi- Blood donation
- 3. Click on Make a blood donation
- 4. Enter your mobile number in the concerned column
- 5. Answer the questions
- 6. Submit
- 7. Take Screenshot of the QR code
- 8. Present the QR code and Emirates ID in the registration desk where you go to donate blood.

#### STEPS TO REGISTER IN DHA APP FOR VOLUNTEER DURING EMERGENCIES

- 1. Download DHA App
- 2. Click on Dammi- Blood donation
- 3. Click on Contact me for emergencies
- 4. Enter your name, mobile number and blood group
- 5. Submit
- 6. Staff will call you whenever there is a need of your blood type.





#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Blood donor should be a resident of the U.A.E. Please bring your Emirates id/GCC id.
- Good general health condition at the time of blood donation. Acceptable range are as follows:
- Age: 18 65 kg. A person between 17 to 18 years age can donate with Parental Consent
- Weight ≥ 50 Kg. The minimum weight of donors between 18 to 21 years age must be 55 kg.
- Hemoglobin: Males- 13.0 g/dl to 18 g/dl; Females- 12.5 g/dl to 16.5 g/dl.
- Systolic BP: 90-180 mm Hg, Diastolic BP: 50-100, .
- Pulse rate: 50-100 pulse/minute and body temperature ≤ 37.5° C.
- Pregnant and lactating women cannot donate blood.
- Donors having travel history to be deferred for 7 days after arrival in UAE. Donors with travel history to malaria endemic countries are deferred for one month.
- Donors who have taken vaccine for covid 19 will be accepted.
- Donors may be deferred on the basis of history of diseases, cosmetic procedures, intake of medicines and clinical signs and symptoms.

## **Post Donation Instructions**

- Dear Generous Donor, kindly follow the below instructions after Blood Donation for Your Own safety
- Eat and drink something healthy before leaving your place of donation.
- Drink extra fluids on the day of and the day after your donation.
- Do not lift heavy objects and avoid strenuous exercise such as tennis, swimming, golf, jogging, etc. during the next 24 hours.
- Do not smoke for an hour after donation.
- Leave your bandage on 3-4 hours
- If you see any new bleeding, raise your arm above your head and apply pressure until the bleeding stops
- If you feel faint, dizzy, or lightheaded, sit or laydown until the feeling passes.
- If you experience any bruising of your arm at the donation site, apply ice in a cloth to the area for 15-20 minutes 3-4 times a day for the first day, second day apply warm cloth for 15-20 minutes 3-4 times a day, a rainbow of colors may see for about 10 days.
- It is advisable to take iron supplements to replenish the iron lost in your donations, as advised by our





#### medical team.

- You can donate whole blood every 2 months, platelet apheresis every 2 weeks, double red cells every 4 months if you meet the eligibility criteria's.

- You test positive for COVID 19 or experience signs and symptoms suggestive of COVID 19 within 5 days of your donation.
- After leaving the blood donor clinic you faint or get a large bruise
- After giving blood you decide your blood should not be used.
- You have a test within the next 12 months that shows you have hepatitis or HIV.
