Birth Certificate (New/Modify/Lost Services)

a birth certificate is issued in the hospital in which the delivery took place. The certificate is being issued in Arabic and English languages. The birth certificate includes the following data:

- Child's name, father's name, mother's name
- Nationalities of both parents
- Religion
- Child's date of birth of the Hijri and Gregorian vears
- Place of birth
- Issuance and signature of the employee and the approval of the Director and seals

Customers can apply for:

- issuing new/modify or replacement a birth certificate for a newborn in Dubai hospital.
- · The concern person or first -degree relatives or other representitives with offical authorization letter can request the service
- For lost birth certificate services, the submission. of police letter is a must
- old birth certificate from Al Makoum hospital from 30/12/1964 to 31/12/1979 can take delivery notification from Dubai hospital, the collection of birth certificate will be in Al Kuwait Hospital.
- old birth certificate for Rashid hospital for the year 1980 to be delivered from Dubai hospital.
- · Old birth certificate for Al Maktoum hospital from 01/01/1980 to 21/05/1983 to be delivered from Dubai hospital.
- Old birth certificate for Rashid hospital for 01/01/1981 to 03/05/1986 to be delivered from Latifa hospital

- The results of laboratory and radiology investigations

- The medical report can only be issued if the last physician's visit does not exceed 6 months
- · Report can only be issued to the customer or to a first-degree relative
- · For any other cases, the customer is directed to the Legal Affairs Department

Issue a New, copy or replacement of Death Certificate

This notification is issued for the death cases inside the Hospital Facilities that came to Hospital

Service delivery procedures and steps:

This service means issuing the death notification to the deceased cases inside the hospital.

- Official declaration of death by the physician.
- Ask the family or the person accompanying to bring the required
- Complete death notification documentation in SALAMA.
- · Direct them to the mortuary to complete the formalities.
- Present ID as an proof of relative/ close friend in the mortuary.
- · Complete the financial clearance.
- · In any other case, the client is directed to the Births and Deaths Registration Committee.



Cardio-Thoracic (Heart and Chest) Surgery

Our services include but are not limited to:

Providing care to patients requiring cardio-thoracic and anaesthesia including:

- Off pump or on pump Valvular heart surgery
- Ascending aortic dissection/aneurysm repair
- Minimally invasive cardiac surgery (MICS) {mitral, tricuspid, ASD}
- Surgery for cardiac tumours
- · Surgery for pulmonary emboli
- · Surgery for infective endocarditis
- Paediatric and adult congenital heart surgery
- ECMO (Extra Corporeal Membrane Oxygenation) service for cardio or pulmonary failure cases
- Endoscopic vein or radial artery harvesting for CABG
 cases
- Thoracic surgery services including: lung and mediastinal tumours surgery, lung biopsy, decortication for lung infection (empyema) surgery
- as well as Video-Assisted Thoracic Surgery (VATS) for various lung conditions including pneumothorax

We also provide surgical backup and anaesthesia service for:

- TAVI, Watchman device, Mitral clip and Mitral ballooning procedures at Dubai and Rashid Hospitals
- Adult pacemaker programme including placement of CRTD devices for patients with failing hearts and for Cardioversion cases
- Paediatric Cath Lab services (including complex congenital anomalies, pulmonary artery stenosis, etc.)
- Cardiac anaesthesia backup for non-cardiac surgery procedures in OT

Adult Critical Care Medicine

Adult critical care medicine services include but are not limited to:

- Monitoring and stabilisation of ICU patients including ventilator management and invasive/non-invasive critical care procedures
- Conducting the necessary diagnostics tests such as basic echography and ultrasound
- Continuous Renal Replacement Therapy (CRRT)
- Invasive and non-invasive haemodynamic monitoring
- Performing diagnostic bronchoscopy and percutaneous tracheostomy

Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery

Oral and maxillofacial surgery services provide the diagnosis and treatment for many hard and soft tissues diseases, injuries and defects in the head, neck, face and jaws.

Those services include but are not limited to:

- · Temporomandibular joint managements
- · Tooth extractions
- Dental implant removal
- · Dental trauma management
- Oral inflammatory/Infection management
- · Oral lesions management
- · Pre-prosthetic surgery
- Surgical root canal treatment
- Oral rehabilitation under GA

Preparation Steps

Medically compromised patients may have to provide a referral letter from their respective physician for clearance.

General Emergency Medicine

General emergency medicine services include but are not limited to:

- · Management of medical emergencies (cardiology, internal medicine, nephrology, oncology, endocrinology, rheumatology, haematology)
- Management of surgical emergencies (general surgery, cardiothoracic surgery, urology, ophthalmology, Ears/Nose and Throat (ENT)
- Management of trauma patients (adult and children) - initial management and stabilisation can be done at Dubai Hospital then transferred to trauma centre (Rashid Hospital) as indicated.
- Management of all urgent/emergency care services, paediatrics emergencies of passengers and staff at Dubai international airport and Al Maktoom international airport.

- · Light meal for dinner with no alcohol
- · Do not have anything to eat or drink after midnight
- Take a shower or bath and wash your body thoroughly using anti-bacterial soap the night before or the morning of surgery
- · Stop taking all aspirin or other non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs, supplements and anticoagulant medications

Clinical Haematology

Haematology department provides services for diagnosis and treatment of all types of benign and malignant haematology. Treatments are offered according to the disease which can be as an in-patient for example: acute leukemia and highly aggressive lymphoma, or as an out-patient or in-daycare/infusion centre.

Procedures which are done in the department are:

- · Bone marrow aspiration and trephine biopsy
- Lumbar puncture and administration of chemotherapy
- · Transfusion of blood products
- · Plasma exchange
- Red cell exchange transfusion for sickle cell disease
- Administration of chemotherapy, monoclonal antibiotics and other immunotherapies

Medical oncology services provided diagnoses, treatment and follow-up for cancer in adults using chemotherapy, hormonal therapy, biological therapy, targeted therapy, and immunotherapy.

Those services include but are not limited to:

- · Breast cancer screening
- · Bowel cancer screening
- Upper or lower GI endoscopy and bronchoscopy
- Comprehensive tumour board, genomic testing, second opinion
- Diagnostic imaging including X-ray, CT scan, MRI, ultrasound imaging, PET scan, PSMA PET scan, bone scan, radioiodine therapy and scan, lutetium therapy, and other radiological techniques as well as interventional radiology services.

Near date appointment/urgent appointment will depend on the availability of the slot in the required clinic. Appointment without referral is not allowed.


