
Physician assessment

Birth Certificate

(New/Modify/Lost Services)

A birth certificate in Arabic is issued according to the jurisdiction in the hospital in which the delivery took place. An English version is provided, as a reference if requested.

The birth certificate includes the following data:

- · Child's name, father's name, mother's name
- Nationalities of both parents
- Religion
- · Child's date of birth of the Hijri and Gregorian vears
- · Place of birth
- Issuance and signature of the employee and the approval of the Director and seals

Customers can apply for:

- Issuing a birth certificate for a newborn in Hatta Hospital
- Issuing a copy, modification or replacement for the lost birth certificate issued from Hatta Hospital
- The concerned person or first-degree relatives or other representatives with official authorisation letter can request the service
- · For lost birth certificate services, the submission of police letter is a must
- Old birth certificate for Rashid Hospital from 30/12/1974 to 31/12/1979 can take delivery notification from Latifa Hospital, (they have to collect birth certificate from Al Baraha Hospital)
- Old birth certificate for Rashid Hospital for the year 1980 to be delivered from **Dubai Hospital**
- Old birth certificate for Rashid Hospital from 01/01/1981 to 03/05/1986 to be delivered from Latifa Hospital

 - 2. Ministry of Foreign Affairs attestation in UAE
- Valid passport copies for the parents and the birth certificate holder

- The medical report can only be issued if the last physician's visit does not exceed 6 months
- · Report can only be issued to the customer or to a first-degree relative
- A medical report form must be filled-out if the request is not from the customer
- For any other cases, the customer is directed to the Legal Affairs Department

- · Complete the financial clearance.








Anaesthesiology

Anaesthesiology services provide pre, during and post operations anaesthesia care and interventions such as general anaesthesia, regional anaesthesia (spinal/epidural anaesthesia) and conscious sedation, in addition to offer pain management care which all aim to ensure patients' safety and comfort.

Paediatric Cardiology

Paediatric cardiology services provide diagnoses and treatment for children's cardiac problems (congenital or acquired cardiac and cardiovascular abnormalities).

Those services include but are not limited to:

- Postnatal and neonatal evaluation to rule-out congenital heart disease and early diagnosis of critical congenital heart disease
- Evaluate and manage patients with congenital heart disease, arrhythmias and acquired heart disease (Kawasaki disease, Viral myocarditis, Rheumatic fever)
- Out-patient care paediatric cardiology clinics where thorough physical examination is conducted and also CXR, ECG, ECHO are performed when indicated
- · Arrhythmia Management
- Manage patients with cardiac complaints in the Emergency Department

- Performing diagnostic bronchoscopy and percutaneous tracheostomy

General Dental Services

General dental services provide evaluation, diagnosis, prevention and/or treatment (nonsurgical, surgical or related procedures) of diseases, disorders, oral trauma and/or conditions of the oral cavity.

Those services include but are not limited to:

- Dental restorations
- Teeth extractions
- Early orthodontic interceptive treatment
- Removable and fixed prosthodontics appliances
- · Root canal treatment for adult and children
- Teeth scaling and polishing
- Preventive dental services
- · Rehabilitation of the mouth
- · Treatment of minor dental injuries

Medically compromised patients may have to provide a referral letter from their respective physician for clearance.

Dermatology

Dermatology services provide the diagnosis and treatment of skin conditions affecting skin, hair, and nails through offering the best medical, surgical and cosmetic dermatologic care.

Those services include but are not limited to:

- Full spectrum of medical and some surgical skin care (skin, hair, nail) for cases such as: acne, dermatitis, eczema, vitiligo, warts, pigmentary disorders, birth marks and vascular disorders
- Treatment and management for systemic diseases associated with skin manifestations (lupus erythematosus, dermatomyositis, scleroderma)
- Treatment and management for sexually transmitted diseases
- Crvotherapy
- · Treatment of birth marks is referred to the Derma Centre

- Stop taking all aspirin or other non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs, supplements and anticoagulant medications

Adult Orthopaedic Surgery

Adult orthopaedic services include but are not limited to:

Trauma management:

- Management of post-traumatic deformities/ fractures and sports injuries
- Management of pelvis, spine and around joint fractures
- Perform revision and reconstruction surgery for septic complications

Orthopaedic surgeries:

- Arthroscopic surgery of knees and shoulders and sport injuries
- · Artificial joint replacement (hip, knee, shoulder, elbow)
- Management of degenerative joint diseases
- · Management of ligament tears through surgery
- · Plasma or stem cells injections to treat joint pain
- · Hand surgery for all traumatic and degenerative problems of the hand and wrist
- · Perform reconstructive surgery using Ilizarov technique
- · Perform corrective surgery after posttraumatic deformities and non-unions
- Provide comprehensive medical care and surgical procedures to treat a wide range of spinal traumas/tumours/infection/ degenerative conditions/deformities
